

Examples of Motions

The following examples show the different ways motions can be written. Minute takers should work with the chair and the group's parliamentary authority to determine a consistent set up for all motions.

1. Motion: It was MOVED, SECONDED, AND CARRIED
"That the Board supported the production of an educational brochure on drug and alcohol addiction."
2. Motion: It was MOVED by Jennifer Becevello and SECONDED that the unit hires three additional clerks. MOTION DEFEATED
3. Dr. Jeff Chin made a motion that Dr. Timothy Luke be granted staff privileges. Dr. Peter Thomas seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.
4. Motion No. 0X-34, moved by Cameron Ward, seconded by Paul Becevello.
Moved, that the city respond to the Ministry of Health's RFP on long-term care facilities.
Motion No. 0X-34 Carried.
5. It was moved that we hold a picnic.
It was moved in amendment by Ms. Nancy Beaker, seconded by Ms. Joan Smith: That we hold a picnic and a dance.
6. It was moved by Ms. Karen Giles that an ad hoc committee for community relations be established. It was moved in amendment by Mr. Adrian Chin that an ad hoc committee for community relations, composed of three Canadian citizens, be established. Amending motion and main motion carried.
